RULES, REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

1. Entries close and must be postmarked by midnight, **September 1**. Entry blanks are in back of Fair Catalog that must be mailed to the Dixie Classic Fair, P. O. Box 7525, Winston-Salem, NC 27109-7525 or brought to the Fair Office, 421 W. 27th Street, Gate 9. Exhibitor's last four (4) of the Social Security Number and age (Youth Sections Only) **MUST** be listed on entry blank to receive premium monies.
2. Competition is open to ages 8 through 17 and Adult - 18 and over. Collections must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor and must have been made by the exhibitor. **Exhibitor may enter only one collection in each category.**
3. Do not enter collections that have been in previous Fairs, unless more items have been added or changed.
4. Attach entry tag to upper right hand corner, front side, where practical. Do not remove claim check. **Exhibit or display can be up to 12" deep, and not over 2' x 3' in width and length. Exhibit/display over size stated will not be accepted.** Leaves and collector cards may be mounted in a loose leaf notebook. Exhibitor must comply with rules and regulations or entry will not be accepted. **Loose specimens will not be accepted. Each and every specimen must be securely mounted. DO NOT USE STRAIGHT PINS OR TAPE TO SECURE COLLECTION. (Exception: Insect category may use Genuine Insect pins to secure insects. When possible, use foam core instead of poster board. Label the collection - what it is, how long it has been collected, etc. COLLECTION MUST BE LABELED TO BE JUDGED. If possible, cover entire collection with clear plastic wrap - secured to the back side.** Display/exhibit may be tilted or elevated for better viewing.
5. Fair reserves the right to refuse any entry that does not comply with rules and regulations and entry will not be judged, displayed only!
6. Care will be given in handling all exhibits; however, the Fair shall not be responsible or liable for loss or damage to any display/exhibit and only on these conditions are exhibits accepted.
7. Exhibits will be accepted with the understanding that they are to remain on display during the entire Fair.
8. Entries will be acknowledged by letter from Fair Office after September 1. This letter will include entry tags for each collection entered. Attach entry tag to upper right hand corner, front side, where practical. Do not remove claim check.
9. Ribbons and premiums will be determined by the Judge, according to the quality of the collections and compliance with rules and regulations. Judges' decision will be final.
10. Premiums will be paid only from the judging results records and NOT from the ribbons or tags on the exhibits.
