## Floriculture - Judging and Premiums

---

---

### JUDGING

Judging will take place Friday at 11:00 am and Wednesday at 11:00 am. No one will be allowed on the show floor except judges, clerks and show officials after judging begins.

### PREMIUMS

1. PREMIUM CHECKS WILL BE VOID 60 DAYS AFTER ISSUE.
2. PREMIUMS WILL BE PAID BY CHECK AFTER FAIR UPON APPLICATION TO THE SUPERINTENDENT AT THE SHOW. Only one check will be issued to an exhibitor for each show covering all premiums won by the individual. CHECKS WILL BE ISSUED TO THE GARDEN CLUBS FOR ITS MEMBERS. **Federal tax ID number for Garden Club must be included on entry blank. Other exhibitors must provide the last four digits of their Social Security number (see entry blank) in order to receive prize money.**

## RULES, REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

---

---

1. **PRE-ENTRY REQUIRED IN ALL DESIGN CLASSES, CONTAINER GROWN PLANTS.** No pre-entry required in other horticultural classes. Bring to Home & Garden Building - see map inside back cover, Bldg. #15.
2. These two flower shows are for AMATEURS ONLY. Classes are not open to commercial growers or professional floral designers. By this is meant: classes are not open to anyone who, at present or in the past, has received his or her livelihood from the growing or designing of classifications listed in this catalog.
3. **NOTE TO GARDEN CLUB MEMBERS: National Garden Clubs, Inc. now permits cash awards to individual garden club members in the Standard Flower Show. If the garden club member wishes the cash premium to be issued to them personally, they must include the last four digits of their social security number on the entry form. If no social security number is entered, the premium will be issued to their garden club.**
4. Judging will be according to the standards of the National Garden Clubs, Inc.
5. Only one entry may be made in any named class. Exhibits entered in the Friday show may not be re-entered in the Wednesday show. Multiple entries permitted in challenge classes - provided **varieties** are different. **ROSES ONLY.**
6. The General Chairman will be present during judging.
7. The Classification Chairman is responsible for checking conformance to the schedule.
8. There must be an emphasis on **fresh** plant material. **No artificial plant material in any division.**
9. The decision of the judges is final.
10. When an individual wins first premium, an exhibit in the same class from the same garden or same family cannot win the second or third premium, even if entered in a different name except in Challenge Classes. Therefore, **only one member of a family may exhibit in any one class.** Because it saves judges' time (since judges cannot see names when judging) and removes the necessity for replacing ribbons and changing prize listing, if this rule is not adhered to, THE FAIR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO WITHHOLD ALL PREMIUMS WON IN ANY CLASS BY ANY FAMILY BREAKING THE RULE.
11. Awards in any class will be given only if merited, and only ONE blue, ONE red, and ONE yellow ribbon will be awarded in each class. Honorable mention ribbons bearing no premium will be awarded as merited in large classes of high quality.
12. Premiums will be paid only from awards as they appear on the books and not from ribbons, as ribbons may become misplaced.
13. The Fair management, the Garden Club Council of Winston-Salem/Forsyth County and Winston-Salem/West Piedmont Judges Council **will not be responsible for damages or loss of property**, though reasonable care will be taken to protect all materials exhibited. (See rules for Design Classes.)

14. The right is reserved to place exhibits in their proper classes if they have been incorrectly entered. Subdividing of any class in the Dixie Classic Fair Flower Show is prohibited.
15. All entries and awards in these sections are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the Fair.
16. All entries (except those in the Horticultural Classes which require no pre-entry) will be acknowledged by letter from the Fair Office and will include entry tags for each exhibit entered. **BE SURE TO BRING THESE ENTRY TAGS WITH YOUR ENTRIES; THEY ARE PROOF THAT YOU HAVE PRE-ENTERED AS REQUIRED AND, THEREFORE SAVE TIME IN ACCEPTING YOUR ENTRIES.**

### Standard System of Awarding Points

**The NGC Standard System of Awards will be used for all competitive judging.**



**Blue Ribbon (1st place) - Must score 90 or more points**

**Red Ribbon (2nd place - Must score 85 or more points**

**Yellow Ribbon (3rd Place) - Must score 80 or more points**

**White Ribbon (4th Place) - Must score 75 or more points**



No material covered by the Plant Protection and Conservation Act (1 July 1980) or the Garden Club of N.C. Plant Conservation List (16 September 1981) shall be used in any exhibit except on its own root and for educational purposes.
